## **Germany**

- 12 *Länder*: Baden-Wuerttemberg, Bayern, Hamburg, Hessen, Mecklenburg-Vorpommern, Niedersachsen, Nordrhein-Westfalen (at Gymnasium), Rheinland-Pfalz, Saarland, Sachsen, Sachsen-Anhalt and Schleswig-Holstein.
- 5 *Länder*: Berlin, Brandenburg, Bremen, Nordrhein-Westfalen (at other lower secondary education institutions apart from Gymnasium) and Thuringen.

## **Hungary**

Under the Public Education Act of 2011, education will be compulsory only until the age of 16. The change is being phased in: the lower age limit (16) applies to students in grade 10 and below; the higher school leaving age (18) continues to apply to students in the grades above.

## **Switzerland**

- 4 cantons: Graubünden, Ticino, Uri and Valais.
- 8 cantons: Appenzell Ausserrhoden, Appenzell Innerrhoden, Lucerne, Nidwalden, Obwalden, Schaffhausen, Schwyz and Zug.
- 14 cantons: Aargau, Bern, Basel-Landschaft, Basel-Stadt, Fribourg, Geneva, Glarus, Jura, Neuchâtel, St. Gallen, Solothurn, Thurgau, Vaud and Zurich.
