


Czech National Agency for International Education (DZS)


- A semi-budgetary organisation, established by the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports of the Czech Republic, responsible for a number of international programmes and activities related to education;
- Grants for international education projects, exchange of youth, mobility of volunteers and professional training of people working with youth;
- Scholarship stays abroad;
- Consultations and professional help for individuals and organisations involved in education projects;
- Information and communication materials;







EEA Grants Programme Education in the Czech Republic

- EEA Grants 2014 2021: the 3rd programming period in the Czech Republic
 - Projects can be realized until April 2024
- Almost 7 million EUR available for projects
- Open to all levels of education (from pre-primary to tertiary level)
- End beneficiaries:
 - pupils, students
 - teaching and non-teaching staff of education institutions



Objectives and national priorities

Objectives:

- Enhanced human capital and knowledge base in the Czech Republic
- Reduction of economic and social disparities within the European Economic Area
- Strengthening of bilateral relations between Norway, Iceland and Liechtenstein and the Czech Republic

Priorities:

- Democracy and citizenship education
- Supporting disadvantaged groups, including the Roma population (inclusive education)
- Initial and in-service teacher training



Programme goals

- 230 students participating in mobility
- 180 teaching and non-teaching staff participating in mobility
- 200 participants taking part in peer-learning activities
- 30 joint intellectual outputs (joint curricula, etc.)
- 10 partnerships following the European Credit System for Vocational Education and Training (ECVET) requirements established
- 70 teachers/multipliers trained in methodology of inclusive education



Eligible applicants and partners


- Only Czech institution can apply for a grant
- Eligible applicants:
 - Schools listed in the register of MEYS
 - Higher education institutions with ECHE
 - Public and national institutions and NGOs focused on school education
- Eligible project partners:
 - any legal entity from the Czech Republic, lceland, Liechtenstein or Norway






Partnership Composition


 At least one partner from Iceland, Liechtenstein or Norway is mandatory for each project





Letter of Intent

- Mandatory annex of the application
- The partner confirms that they agree to participate in the project activities
- Description of the tasks and responsibilities of the applicant and the partner(s)
- Signature of both (all) parties





Partnership Agreement

- Draft mandatory before the issuing of the Grant Agreement
- Separate Partnership Agreement for each partner
- Recommended to have it signed by legal representatives of both parties
- Both parties shall agree on:
 - their main roles and responsibilities within the project
 - financial and payment arrangements
 - distribution of the project budget among the partners



Calls for Proposals

- Launch of calls: November 1, 2019
- Submission deadlines: February/March 2020
- Submission of the application via online system https://eea-app.dzs.cz/eea/

Programme Outcomes

- 1. Institutional cooperation projects Institutional cooperation at all levels of education (focus on democracy and active citizenship education)
- 2. Mobility projects Improved skills and competences of students, staff and other educational experts all all levels of education
- 3. VET projects Improved quality of work-based learning and youth entrepreneurship
- 4. Inclusive education projects Increased inclusion of disadvantaged groups, including the Roma population



Institutional cooperation projects I.

- Expected outcome:
 - strengthened collaboration between
 Czech and donor institutions
- Participants of activities:
 - staff of the applicant's and partner's institutions
- Priorities:
 - democracy and active citizenship education
 - inclusive education





Institutional cooperation projects II.

- Project duration:
 - 12 or 24 months
- Total allocated budget for the 2nd call:
 - 936 000 €
- Grant per project:
 - 20 000 € 150 000 €
- Submission deadline: February 19, 2020
- Expected No. of approved projects: 10





Institutional cooperation projects III.

- Expected outputs:
 - intellectual outputs (modernised curricula, teaching materials, joint study programmes and courses)
 - peer-learning and exchange of good practices (workshops, round tables, seminars...)
- Impact on school education
- Implementation of innovative practices in the field of education
- Examples of project topics: school parliament, civic activism, student elections, media literacy, human rights, solidarity, European integration, equal opportunities



Mobility projects I.

- Expected outcome:
 - improved skills and competences of participants
- Participants of activities:
 - students in secondary and higher education
 - teaching and non-teaching staff at all levels of education
 - educational experts
- You can combine various participants in one application
- Priorities:
 - students-future teachers
 - students from disadvantaged groups





Mobility projects II.

- Partnership: only one Czech school, from one to several institutions in the donor states
- Project duration:
 - 13 months
- Total allocated budget for the 2nd call:
 - 973 400 €
- Grant per project:
 - 1500 € 100 000 €
- Submission deadline: February 12, 2020
- Expected No. of approved projects: 14





Types of mobilities

- Students (aged 14 and older)
 - study period abroad (1 6 months)
 - exchanges of groups (1 4 weeks)
 - traineeship (1 4 weeks)
 - 1 week = 5 days of activity + 2 days of travel
- Staff
 - study visits (1 4 weeks)
 - job shadowing (1 4 weeks)
 - teaching assignments (1 4 weeks)
 - 1 week = 3 consecutive days of working activity + 2 days of travel





VET projects I.

- Expected outcome:
 - improved quality of work-based learning and youth entrepreneurship
- Participants of activities:
 - staff of school and partner's enterprises
 - students
- Priorities:
 - projects supporting social inclusion
 - VET schools in disadvantaged areas
 - VET schools enrolling students from disadvantaged groups





VET projects II.

- Project duration:
 - 13 months
- Total allocated budget:
 - 746 900 €
- Grant per project:
 - 10 000 € 50 000 €
- Submission deadline: March 4, 2020
- Expected No. of approved projects: 20





VET projects – types of activities

- ECVET partnership
 - Study visits
 - Redesigning of curricula

 - Training activities for students
 - Training courses for teachers and tutors





ECVET partnership I.

The aims are:

- to improve the quality of work-based learning,
- to respond to labour market needs,
- to integrate work-based learning into school curricula,
- to follow the ECVET principles
- Partnership: one project partner must be an enterprise
 (e.g. Czech school + Czech enterprise + Norwegian institution)





ECVET partnership II.

- Examples of topics:
 - new study materials and tools
 - recognition and validation of knowledge and skills
 - professional development of staff
 - support of learners with special needs in their completion of education cycles and facilitation of their transition to the labour market
 - support of learners from disadvantaged groups in their completion of education






ECVET partnership - Study visits

- Participants: staff of school and of enterprise (min. 1 employee belonging to school staff + 1 employee belonging to enterprise staff)
- Content: presentation, job shadowing, exchange of good practice, sharing of know- how, discussion
- Results of the study visit will be used to integrate the work-based learning into student training and/or school curricula – to create at least one unit of a learning outcome





VET projects – types of activities


- ECVET partnership
 - Study visits
 - Redesigning of curricula
- Youth entrepreneurship
 - Training activities for students
 - Training courses for teachers and tutors





ECVET partnership – Redesigning of curricula

- Creation of an intellectual output e.g. study material and tools, updated curriculum, guidelines for teachers and tutors
- Integration of work-based learning into student training and school curricula create at least one unit of a learning outcome
- Optional: short-term pilot international mobility (1-2 weeks) for Czech VET students to test and implement the results of cooperation with partners

Youth entrepreneurship

The aims are:

- to increase a sense of initiative and entrepreneurship among young people,
- to react to labour market needs,
- to prepare at least one activity for VET students or teachers and tutors,
- to organise transnational teaching or training activities for project staff (up to 2 weeks) optional
- Partnership: Czech school + Norwegian institution (enterprise is not mandatory)



Youth entrepreneurship - Training activities for students


- Participants VET students
- Training, workshop, seminar
- Examples of topics:
 - student firms
 - promotion of youth entrepreneurship opportunities
 - innovative practices in the field of entrepreneurship





Youth entrepreneurship - Training courses for teachers and tutors

- Participants teachers, tutors
- support of professional development of teacher and tutors
- improvement of their skills and competences to support entrepreneurship among young people





Inclusive education projects

- Expected outcome:
 - increased inclusion of Roma students/pupils through raising awareness about this issue in the education of teachers in pre-primary, primary and secondary schools
- Which institutions can participate:
 - educational NGOs
 - public institutions
 - schools at all levels of education
- Activities:
 - development of competences and classroom-based skills of teachers and multipliers
 - long-term support of teachers (trainings, follow-up, mentoring....)



Inclusive education projects

- Project duration:
 - 12 or 24 months
- Total allocated budget for the 2nd call:
 - 474100€
- Grant per project:
 - 50 000 € 200 000 €
- Co-financing:
 - 10% in the case of NGOs
- Submission deadline: March 11, 2020
- Expected No. of approved projects: 3





Project financing I.

- Grant rate = up to 100% of eligible expenditure (no co-financing required)
- If the Project promoter is an NGO, the project grant rate will be 90% of eligible expenditure (10% co-financing)

| | First payment after signature of Grant agreement | Second advance payment after Interim report | Final payment (reimbursement) |

| Mobility projects | 80 % | 20 % | |
| 12 or 13 months' projects | 80 % | | 20 % |

Project financing II.

- The project grant shall take the form of standard scales of unit costs
- Proof of expenditure is limited to proof of relevant units (e.g. days, number of participants)
 - Simplification of administrative procedures
 - > Reducing the risk of error
- Indirect costs are not eligible





Budget categories – unit costs

- Travel
- Subsistence
- Transnational project meeting support
- Staff costs
- Multiplier events
- Linguistic support
- Project management and implementation support/Organisational support for mobility





Budget categories – actual incurred expenditures

- Special needs support
- Exceptional costs to support participants with fewer opportunities
- Exceptional costs related to subcontracting or purchase of goods and services






From ideas to application

- Choose the Outcome (Institutional cooperation project, Mobility project, VET project, Inclusive education project)
- Define the target groups (e.g. students, staff)
- Select activities (e.g. study visit, redesigning of curricula, training activities)
- Cooperate on the concept and description of the project with project partners
- Sign Letter of Intent with all the partners
- Fill in the application
