Expertise of the Team Leader

Pietro Castelli Gattinara is Associate Professor at Cevipol, Université Libre de Bruxelles and Marie Skłodowska-Curie Fellow at Sciences Po (CEE). He obtained his PhD in Political and Social Sciences (2014) from the European University Institute; since 2017, he is a research fellow of the Center for Research on Extremism (C-REX), University of Oslo and the convenor of the ECPR Summer School Concepts and Methods to study far-right politics. His research concentrates on political conflict in Europe, with a special focus on the interplay between social movements and political parties in comparative perspective. Specifically, he is interested in the rise of new structuring cleavages in European societies, in far-right political participation, and in the relationship between traditional and new media. On the one hand, he studies the drivers of transnational public controversies about migration, citizenship and diversity ([MAM](#) project, Research Council of Norway). On the other, he looks at the realignment of far-right mobilization in the electoral and protest arenas (project [FARPE](#)), and at the diffusion of far-right messages in national public spheres (MSCA project [FARMEC](#)).

Expertise of the department

The Cevipol (Centre d'Etude de la Vie Politique) is a research center of the Philosophy and Social Sciences Department of the Université libre de Bruxelles. It specializes in political sociology and comparative politics. Research within the Cevipol focuses on political life, institutions, actors, and the norms and resources of democratic systems. The processes of action, mobilisation, and legitimation are examined with both qualitative and quantitative methods, from a contemporary perspective that takes into account the long view. While consistently opening fresh empirical debates, the Cevipol updates traditional themes of political science: the distribution of power and resources among social groups, the different forms of

authority, elite recruitment, conflicts between interests, identity or memory, and the weight of norms and values.
