The Company was extended with new divisions and renamed in 2021.</p> <p>The Express Innovation Agency is an innovation service subsidiary of the National Research, Development and Innovation Office, supporting the Hungarian innovation ecosystem. The Agency actively supports the innovation ecosystem from youth education to the gateway to the international market.</p> <p>With new talent management programs, innovation promotion, trainings and mentoring, we also reach out to the youngest generation, helping growing businesses with valorisation, mentoring and incubation support. The Agency encourages start-ups to reach the next level with international contacts and preparation for European funds. Our goal is to help the entire innovation ecosystem, regardless of the discipline, from planting the core of innovation to market utilization, thus becoming an information and active support hub. Our mission is to divert the focus of the innovation management from a funding agency of projects, to a client-based approach. The new approach will concentrate on improving the service to the clients assuming, that improved service will lead to the desired results, regarding the increase in the innovation with the help of improving attractiveness of the talented actors in the ecosystems.</p> <p>The International Division of the Agency provides services primarily in the promotion of international research and development applications and consulting services related to international applications. The priority areas for Horizon Europe are cluster 5 (Climate, Energy and Mobility) and cluster 6 (Food, Bioeconomy, Natural Resources, Agriculture and Environment). One of the Division's main tasks is to support Horizon's participation in European missions and partnerships.</p> <p>The International Division is also responsible for supporting communication, coordination and promotion activities related to the Horizon Europe program, in particular to encourage the application activity of domestic participants and to increase the number of successful applications. To this end, the Division also organizes personal consultations and information events for a wider range of participants.</p>

Reference of Call/topic of interest	<u>HORIZON-WIDERA-2022-ERA-01-50: Developing an effective ERA talent pipeline</u>
Description of the project idea	<p>In Hungary there are already existing well-functioning programmes, most of them co-ordinated by the National Research, Development and Innovation Office to support the career development of PhD students and postdocs.</p> <p>One of them is the Co-operative Doctoral Fellowship Programme which aim is to strengthen the relationship between academic research and the industry (as well as other areas of the non-academic sector). The New National Excellence Programme supports young talents already from high school diploma until becoming a young researcher after a postdoc period.</p> <p>At the forefront of the concept of the Postdoctoral Programme in Innovation is the launch of an innovation-oriented application system that can be positioned at the postdoctoral and premium postdoctoral level. Based on the construction of the university innovation ecosystem, it could play a central role in attracting young researchers and talents, and in accelerating the brain circulation at the ERA level.</p> <p>The Hungarian practices in early career development of researchers could be either the basis of the common academic researcher's career structure to be created in the project or one practice that the project could consider. The Hungarian experiences could contribute to all the expected outcomes.</p> <p>It is of high significance for us to strengthen the Regional Innovation Scheme (RIS) which contributes to reducing the innovation divide.</p> <p>In the frame of EIT RIS, would a new concept and approach relate to the brain circulation instead of the normal mobility schemes, which are considered as traditional instruments. We are pleased to see inclusion of the EIT-HEI initiatives in the widening strategy of Hungary.</p>
